Plastic results in greenhouse gas emissions at each stage of the lifecycle—from its birth as fossil fuels through refining and manufacture to the massive emissions at the end of life

Plastics addressed as a "marine litter" problem Agreed to establish an Ad-Hoc Open-Ended Expert Group to address plastic pollution and recognized a need for an international treaty

Agreed to create "an international legally binding instrument" to "end plastic pollution"

GLOBAL PLASTICS TREATY Treaty Ambition – A Conceptual Guide

High ambition

dramatically reduced production

Medium ambition

phaseout of most problematic polymers and additives

Low ambition

improved waste management, some transparency measures

<mark>Status quo</mark>

no treaty, unchecked production growth

Worse than no treaty

endorses plastic-to-energy, plastic credits, and other false solutions

LOBAL PLASTICS TREATY

Recommendations for the Korean government

	Focus on reducing plastic production	Cap and phasedown of all production or phaseout of primary plastic
۲	Scale up reuse	Binding reuse/return targets/standards/funding
	Just transition for waste pickers and affected communities	Include workers and affected communities in the elaboration of national implementation plans
۲	Polluter and producer accountability	EPR for reduction and reuse
	No loopholes, do no harm	Address all plastics, no dirty technologies, no offsetting, no worsening environmental injustice
